

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS (FOREIGN LL.B. GRADUATES)

1. Persons possessing the under-mentioned qualifications shall be exempt from the Sri Lanka Law College Entrance Examination:-
 - (i) A graduate in laws of a University in the United Kingdom or Canada or Australia or the United States of America, recognized by the Incorporated Council of Legal Education; *
 - (ii) A graduate in laws of any other University recognized by the Incorporated Council of Legal Education provided that such degree is recognized as an entry qualification for a course of professional studies for admission to the Bar in the country in which such degree was obtained;
 - (iii) A person who has been duly enrolled and admitted to the legal profession in a country in the Commonwealth, recognized by the Incorporated Council of Legal Education.

2. Application for admission

An application form for admission to the Sri Lanka Law College could be obtained from the Office, paying Rs. 1000/- to the Credit of the Incorporated Council of Legal Education at the Standard Chartered Bank, Mihindu Mawatha, Colombo 12 and forwarding the Treasurer's receipt for the said payment.

3. Required documents

The documents (photocopies should be certified by the applicant) which should be submitted with the application form for admission to the Sri Lanka Law College by persons who possess the LL.B. Degree are:-

- (1) Originals of LL.B. Degree (Convocation) Certificate and Detailed Result Sheet/s (also Higher National Diploma/Ed Hat Certificates as the case may be) with photo-copies;
- (2) Original/s of G.C.E. (O/L) Examination Certificate/s in proof of Credit passes in English and Sinhala/Tamil languages, with photo-copies;
- (3) Original of Birth Certificate with a photo-copy;
- (4) One Character Certificate with a photo-copy;
- (5) Two (2) coloured photographs (Passport size - one should be certified by the person issuing the Character Certificate);
- (6) One photo-copy of the National Identity Card.
