Instructions to Candidates

Further to the Notice published yesterday 9th March 2021.

Preliminary/Intermediate Examination Candidates

1. Sri Lanka Law College Identity Card

- Candidates who do not have a **Sri Lanka Law College Identity Card** must bring either their National Identity Card or their passport to the examination hall.
- Candidates who have applied for, but have not received a Sri Lanka Law College Identity Card will receive the same on the first day of the examination at the examination hall.

2. Admission Cards

- **Admission Cards** have been posted to all Preliminary/Intermediate Examination candidates.
- In the event a **Preliminary Examination** candidate does not receive the Admission Card via post by **3 p.m. on Friday 12th March**, such candidate must inform the College via Whatsapp.
- In the event an **Intermediate Examination** candidate does not receive the Admission Card via post by **3 p.m. on Monday 15th March**, such candidate must inform the College via Whatsapp.

- Such candidates will be informed regarding the hall where their exam is to be held and receive a duplicate Admission Card at the hall.

3. Withdrawals

- The Admission Card carries the date by which a candidate may withdraw from the examination. Candidates who wish to withdraw must do so by communicating the same by letter addressed to **The Principal, Sri Lanka Law College, 244 Hulftsdorp Street Colombo 12**. Withdrawal letters may be posted under registered cover or handed in at the College Office.
- Preliminary and Intermediate candidates who do not receive their Admission Cards via post on the above stated dates and wish to withdraw must communicate the same to the College via Whatsapp.

Final Examination Candidates

- **Barristers** and Candidates sitting the Final Examination under the **Old Syllabus** have already been advised.
- Corresponding information relating to the other Final Examination candidates will be communicated shortly.
- Whilst the Commercial Law I paper which was to be held on 17th March will be moved to a new date due to unavoidable circumstances, every effort is being made to hold the other Final Examination papers as per the timetable already published.
