## Attendance at Lectures

### Preliminary, Intermediate and Final Years – 2018

Students who have attended at lectures 50% & above are qualified to apply to sit the October, 2018 examinations.

Student who have attended between 1% - 49% are required to make appeals regarding their poor attendance.

Further, Preliminary and Intermediate Year Students are required to write **FOUR articles** on any **FOUR areas** of their choice and are to be handed over on or before 10<sup>th</sup> of January, 2019 to the Principal's office.

Final Year Students are required to write **SIX Plaints** and **SIX Deeds** and are to be handed over on or before 22<sup>nd</sup> of October, 2018 to the Principal's office.

Students who have not attended lectures in the academic year 2018 are required to attend lectures in the year 2019.

In addition to above, those who were provisionally registered for the academic year 2018 as they had to sit the examination held in April, 2018 and have passed respective examination will be allowed to sit the next examination, provided they have attended lectures at least 10% during the year. Students who have not obtained 10% may appeal regarding their poor attendance for consideration.

Further, Preliminary & Intermediate year students who were provisionally registered are required to write **THREE articles** on any **THREE areas** of their choice and are to be handed over on or before 10<sup>th</sup> of January, 2019 to the Principal's office.

Only hand written legible papers will be accepted.

Please hand over appeals personally to Mrs. Udeshika at my office on or before the 11<sup>th</sup> of October, 2018.
