Violation of Rule 60

At a meeting held on 24th June 2025, the Incorporated Council of Legal Education decided to **terminate the studentship** of all Attorneys-at-Law examination candidates found in breach of Rule 60 of the Rules of the Incorporated Council of Legal Education.

Rule 60:

“Candidates on entering the examination room shall give up to the supervisor or supervisors all books and papers in their immediate possession at the time. After the commencement of the Examination any candidate found talking to another, or copying from or using notes or books or having the same in his possession shall be instantly expelled from the room by the supervisor or supervisors, and his case reported to the Principal who shall bring it to the notice of the Council.”
