Students who intend sitting for the upcoming October 2026 Examination are requested to download the relevant Examination Application Form from the Sri Lanka Law College website: www.sllc.lk

Instructions for Candidates

- The Examination Fees and other payments should be paid to any branch of the **Hatton National Bank (A/C NO 063020073300)**. Please refer to the Notice “**Payment of Fees Via Banks**”, posted on our website.
- The total Examination Fee payable is as follows:
 - For students who registered before 5th January 2023: **LKR 1,000** per subject multiplied by the number of subjects in the Preliminary, Intermediate or Final Examination.
 - For students registered after 5th January 2023: **LKR 2,500** per subject multiplied by the number of subjects in the Preliminary, Intermediate or Final Examination.**(Please refer to the Gazette No 2313/49 of 5th January 2023 for further details).**
- Students who have submitted withdrawal forms or medicals for not sitting previous examinations, must pay the following fees:
 - Withdrawals based on medicals :
 - For students who registered before 5th January 2023: Total exam fee for the October 2026 exam + LKR 500
 - For students registered after 5th January 2023: Total exam fee for the October 2026 exam + LKR 2000
 - Withdrawals not based on medicals :
 - For students who registered before 5th January 2023: Total exam fee for the October 2026 exam + LKR 1000
 - For students registered after 5th January 2023: Total exam fee for the October 2026 exam + LKR 5000

(Please refer to the Gazette No 2313/49 of January 5th January 2023 for further details).

- Foreign LL.B graduates who failed to pay the lecture fees for the Intermediate or Final Year must pay:
 - If he or she registered before 5th January 2023 :
 - Intermediate Year – LKR 15,000
 - Final Year – LKR 19,500
 - If he or she registered after 5th January 2023 :
 - Intermediate Year – LKR 40,500
 - Final Year – LKR 55,500
- The renewal registration fee applicable where necessary:
 - For students who registered before 5th January 2023: LKR 2,500 per year
 - For students who registered after 5th January 2023: LKR 15,000 per year

(If the lecture fees have been paid for a particular year, there is no need to pay renewal registration fee for that year.)

N.B.

- Optional Subjects once selected cannot be changed.
- Please print the application on an A4 paper on both sides.

You must drop your application between **10th – 24th August, 2026** into the box placed at the reception of the Law College (payment must be made prior to this). Late applications will be accepted from **25th August, 2026 – 03rd September, 2026**, subject to the late payment fee of LKR 15,000.
